

# How to configure PPPoE for a Linksys Router

1. Open Internet Explorer and in the “Address Bar” field type 192.168.1.1

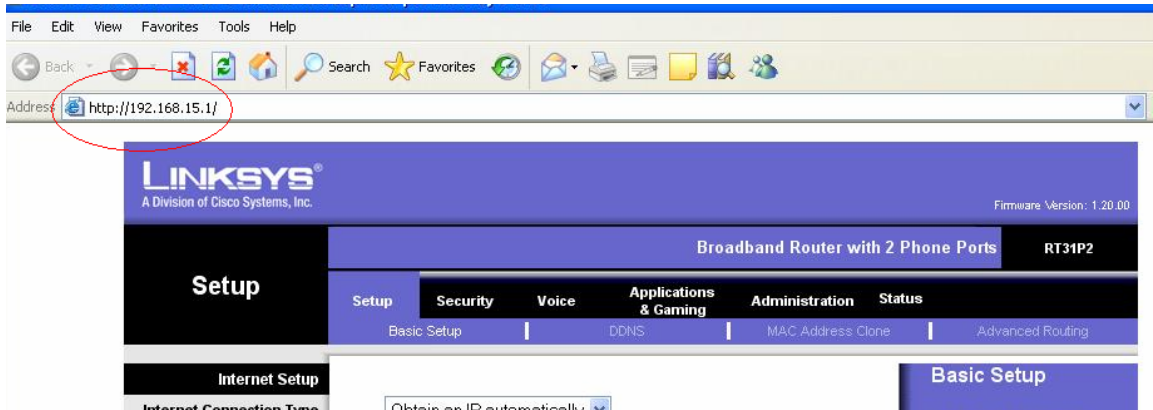


Figure 1 Internet Explorer: Linksys Setup page

2. Click the dropdown menu for “Internet Connection” and select PPPoE

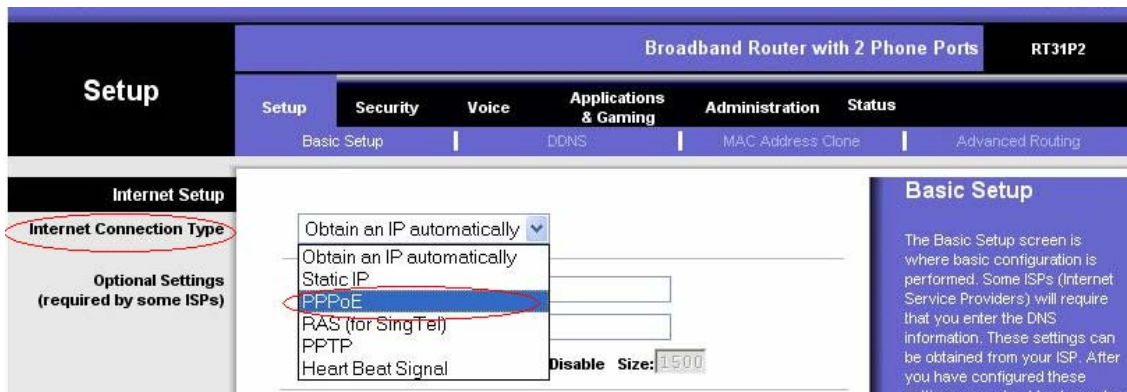



Figure 2 Internet Explorer: Linksys Setup page 2

3. Once you have selected the PPPoE option, you will then need to add your username and password. Please ensure you add your full email address (ie username@e-wire.net.au). Please also ensure there is nothing in the “Service Name” field. The remainder of the information should be left unmodified, unless instructed by e-wire staff.
